#### 2015-01-12.10 <u>MUNICIPAL REPRESENTATION - INSTALLATION OF HYDRO-QUEBEC NEXT</u> <u>GENERATION METERS</u>

WHEREAS the Municipality of North Hatley issued a request for a moratorium to the Quebec government and Hydro-Québec through a resolution which was passed unanimously at the regular council meeting of April 2, 2012;

WHEREAS Hydro-Québec recently sent out correspondence announcing the installation of the next generation meters on the territory of the Municipality of North Hatley;

WHEREAS a great number of citizens in Quebec have expressed various concerns regarding the potential effects of these next generation meters, whether they are communicating or non-communicating;

WHEREAS Hydro-Québec is unable to unequivocally reassure the citizens in Quebec as to the potential effects of these next generation meters;

WHEREAS the citizens have experienced difficulty in reaching Hydro-Québec client services since receiving the notices regarding the installation of the meters;

UPON PROPOSAL DULY MOVED BY CLAUDE VILLENEUVE THE COUNCILLORS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVE

THAT the Town Council ask Hydro-Québec to postpone its project for the installation of the next generation meters on the territory of the Municipality of North Hatley;

THAT the Town Council urge Hydro-Québec to proceed with additional research toward finding a technology that will dispel the concerns of the citizens and to raise awareness in order to ensure its promotion:

THAT the Town Council urge Hydro-Québec to provide a Customer Service that is capable of responding to the many calls from their subscribers;

THAT a copy of this resolution be sent to the "ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Occupation du territoire" and to the "Régie de l'énergie du Québec".

# 2015-01-12.11 CCUP - MINOR DEROGATION - 55, RUE MAIN

WHEREAS the CCUP held a Regular Meeting on January 7th 2015;

WHEREAS Resolution 2015-004 regarding a request for a permit to build a emergency stairway at 55, rue Main was passed with the recommendation that the permit be approved by the Town Council;

WHEREAS the owner is required to install an emergency exit in accordance with the requirements of the Régie du bâtiment du Québec (RGQ);

WHEREAS a proposal was prepared by the architectural firm Cimaise;

## **JANUARY 12, 2015**

WHEREAS the proposal involves extending the terrace over the Massawippi River toward the bridge and to attach a stairway 1,100 mm wide which will open onto the terrace at street level;

WHEREAS the current by-laws prohibit this type of construction on or above the bank or the littoral zone;

WHEREAS the application of the regulation would cause substantial harm to the owner;

WHEREAS the authorization to proceed would not cause infringement of the rights of enjoyment of the owners of the neighbouring properties;

THAT the permit be issued subject to the following conditions:

- THAT the stairway be used as an emergency exit only;
- THAT the architectural design respect the style of the building and fit in well with the surroundings;
- THAT, in any future project, an alternative solution be considered and that the requested emergency exit be no longer required and be dismantled. Unless the alternative solution is unreasonable (with respect to costs and impact on the configuration of the premises).

UPON PROPOSAL DULY MOVED BY ALAIN BEAULIEU THE COUNCILLORS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVE

TO accept the recommendation of the CCUP.

## 2015-01-12.12 CCUP - MINOR DEROGATION - 4210, CHEMIN MAGOG

WHEREAS the CCUP held a Regular Meeting on January 7th 2015;

WHEREAS Resolution 2015-005 regarding a request for a minor derogation allowing an extension on the front of the house located at 4210, rue Main was passed with the recommendation that the request be denied by the Town Council;

WHEREAS the extension of 4.87 metres would increase significantly the encroachment on the front setback by about 6.87 metres;

WHEREAS there already is a difference in the alignment of the façades with the buildings in the area and that this difference in alignment would be increased;

WHEREAS it is stated in Article 3.6 of the by-law that a derogating construction protected under acquired rights can only be extended or modified subject to the current regulation;

WHEREAS the shape and the dimension of the 6,968.7 square metre lot offer the owner other construction options;

WHEREAS the project does not meet the urban planning standards;
