Job Summary:

Under the supervision of the Public Works Foreman, the employee will perform various duties related to snow removal, work, maintenance or repair of municipal roads, sewer and water systems, buildings, parks and green spaces, based on the season.

The employee will also work on vehicle, machinery and equipment maintenance for various work projects.

Skills and Qualifications:

The Public Works employee must have aptitudes for manual work. The employee must be in good health and have no physical limitations, enjoy working outdoors and be able to withstand extreme temperatures. The employee must be autonomous and show proof of initiative when required, and fully participate in teamwork projects.

Requirements:

- High-school diploma;
- Valid class 3 drivers permit, or in the process of becoming;
- Experience in snow removal work, required;
- Basic knowledge of the construction industry, an asset;
- Experience in municipal public works, an asset;
- Worksite health and safety certification, an asset;
- Training in intervention techniques or strategies, an asset;
- Within the context of a bilingual village, ease of communication in both French and English.

The position is on a full-time basis. The work schedule is variable based on the season. Working conditions and remuneration will be discussed with candidates selected for an interview.
