





By-Law 2008-525 is meant to prevent the spread of zebra mussels and other invasive species.

The responsibility is ours to protect our lake and our river from this environmental threat! Boat owners are required to have their boats washed at the wash station in order to receive a certificate before heading out on the water.

User certificates for residents are available at the following costs:
