Job Summary Description :

Under the supervision of the Public Works Foreman, the employee performs various building, park and green space maintenance, snow removal, road, sewer and water system repairs, according to seasonal needs. The employee also participates in the maintenance of vehicles, machinery and equipment used for the various jobs.

Tasks Include:

- Carry out work related to the maintenance of the road network: clearing brush, signs, road repairs;
- Carry out snow removal operations during the winter season (road network, sidewalks, parking lots, building access, etc.);
- Participate in various maintenance work on the water and sewer system;
- Carry out maintenance work on municipal parks and trails;
- Carry out minor repairs and routine maintenance of buildings and grounds.

Requirements:

- High school diploma, vocational diploma or equivalent (an asset);
- Relevant experience in a municipal environment (an asset);
- A combination of education and experience may be considered.

- Ability to work in a team and interact with the public;
- Possess manual skills;
