# 2022-03-07.13 <u>SPECIFIC LARGE-SCALE OR SPURAMUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (PPA-ES)</u>

Resolution to approve expenditures under the 2019 financial assistance award for the PPA-ES financial program.

WHEREAS the Municipality of the Village of North Hatley has taken into account the terms and conditions for the application of the Specific Improvement Projects (SIP) component of the Local Road Assistance Program (LRAP) and undertakes to respect them;

WHEREAS the road network for which an application for financial assistance has been granted is under municipal jurisdiction and is eligible for the PAVL;

WHEREAS the work must be completed no later than the end of the third calendar year from the date of the Minister's announcement letter;

WHEREAS the work completed or the costs associated with it are eligible for the PAVL;

WHEREAS the accountability form V-0321 has been duly completed;

WHEREAS the transmission of the accountability of the projects must be done at the end of the realization of the work or at the latest on December 31 of the third calendar year of the date of the letter of announcement of the Minister;

WHEREAS, payment is conditional upon the Minister's acceptance of the Project Accountability Report;

WHEREAS, if the report is deemed to be in compliance, the Minister will make a payment to the municipalities based on the list of work that he has approved, without exceeding the maximum amount of assistance as it appears in the letter of announcement;

WHEREAS the financial assistance is allocated over a period of three calendar years, starting from the date of the Minister's letter of announcement;

WHEREAS the financial assistance is divided into three annual instalments corresponding to the total of the supporting documents received up to a maximum of :

1) 40% of the financial assistance granted, for the first installment;

2) 80% of the financial assistance granted minus the first instalment, for the second instalment;

3) 100% of the financial assistance granted minus the first two installments, for the third installment;

WHEREAS work done after the third anniversary of the letter of announcement is not eligible;

WHEREAS other sources of funding for the work have been declared;

Be it resolved that May 17 be proclaimed INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST HOMOPHOBIA AND TRANSPHOBIA and that this day be celebrated as such.
